Read Deut. 6:1-9

"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 5Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength." Deuteronomy 6:4-5

## The Shema

"Shema" in Hebrew is translated to "Hear" or "Listen."

To fully "Shema" means to <u>listen</u>, pay attention, and <u>respond to</u>.

The call of Deuteronomy 6:1-9 is not only to personally live out the Shema but to also **pass it** on to the **next generation**.

"These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. 7 Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you **sit** at home and when you **walk** along the road, when you **lie down** and when you **get up**."

Deuteronomy 6:6-7

"Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates." Deuteronomy 6:9

"Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not part from it." Proverbs 22:6 (NIV 84)

## Three powers that you have...

- 1. The power to set the **example**.
- 2. The power to give an **apology**.
- 3. The power to **invest**.

It is approximately **936 weeks** from **birth till high school graduation**.

- Once Kindergarten starts 624 weeks
- At the start of 6<sup>th</sup> grade <u>364</u> weeks
- At the start of High School 208 weeks
- And Parents of Seniors this next year <u>52</u> weeks

This is the responsibility of the **family** and the **church**.

What if we were to seek 5 caring adults to invest in the spiritual journey of one kid?

The truth is that a willing heart is a game changer.

- 4. Let's identify the 5.
